Guidelines:

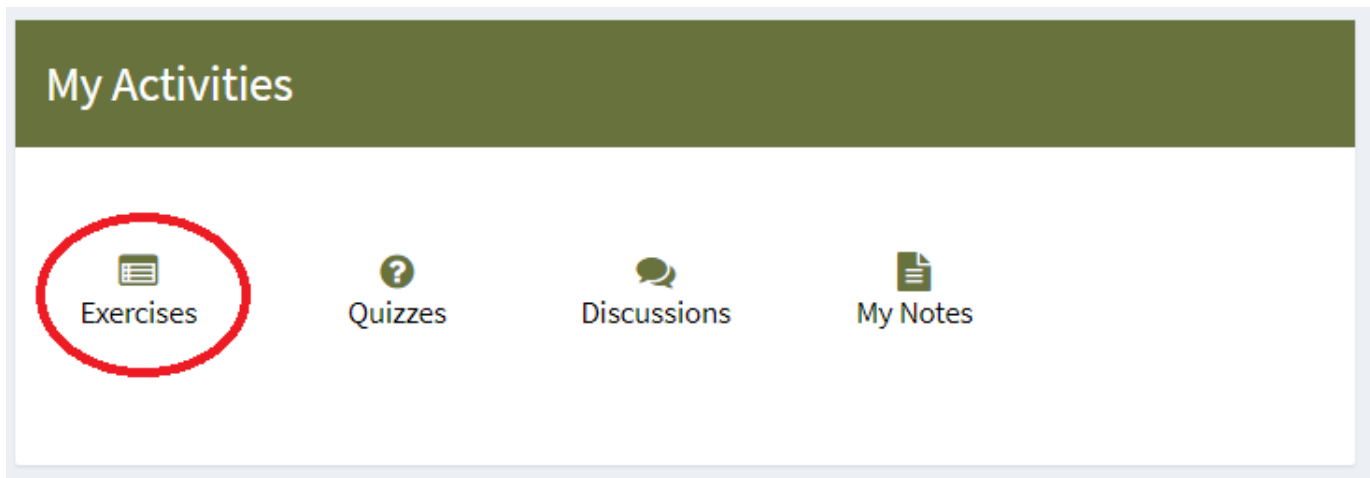
- Watch Video Lesson Nos. **54-56, 62-77** before attempting the exercise.

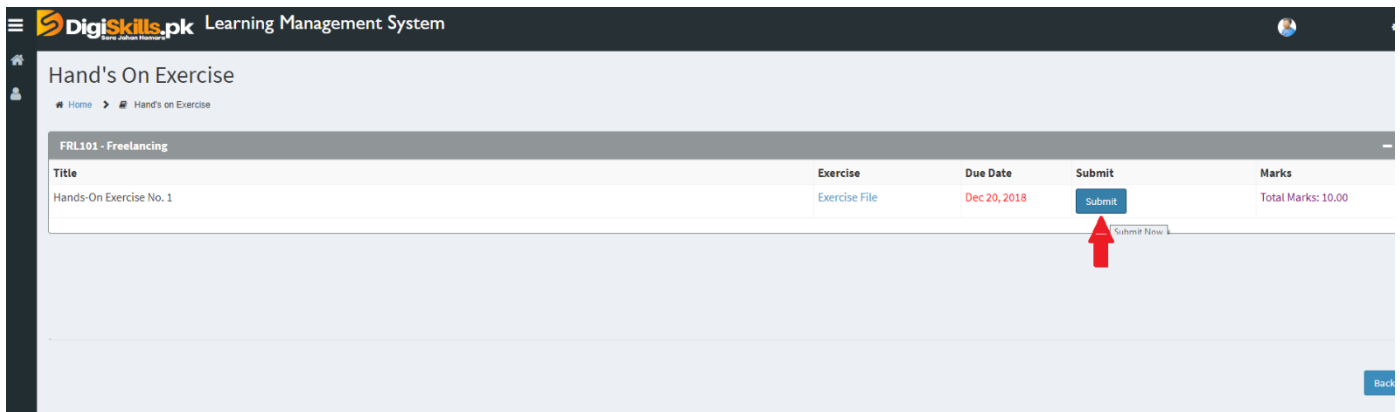
How to submit solution file on LMS?
