- Write introduction on the 2nd slide and Pros and Cons on the 3rd and 4th slide.
- Write the conclusion and cite references on the last slide. For citing references, write the title of the article/blog and URL of the website you have taken reference from.
- Use relevant pictures and graphs to complement your written content.
- Make sure to follow the rules of writing presentations taught by the Instructor.
- Save the file on PowerPoint with the default extension(.ppt, .pptx)
- Keep the name of the file simple e.g. CWE03.



 - > Be submitted in MS PowerPoint format only.


How to submit solution file on LMS?
